Center Hosts Free Nonprofit Legal Clinic

Dallas- The **Center for Nonprofit Management** will host a free Nonprofit Legal Clinic Thursday, August 24 from 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Center for Nonprofit Management in Dallas. The clinic, featuring free customized legal advice from nonprofit experts, is sponsored by the **Dallas Association of Young Lawyers Foundation** and the **Texas Bar Foundation**.

The event offers nonprofit executives and board members an evening to schedule brief, confidential, one-on-one consultations with attorneys specializing in areas of law that are crucial to running nonprofit organizations. Whether it's an employment matter, a governance problem, a sticky issue involving intellectual property and copyright law, or another troubling legal concern, the program allows nonprofits to get the professional legal attention they deserve.

The sessions will take place on Thursday, August 24 from 5:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Center for Nonprofit Management, 2902 Floyd Street in Dallas. Time slots are limited, so agency representatives must register no later than Thursday, August 3 by 5 p.m. to secure a spot. The event is free, however registration is required.
